Take part in an archaeological "dig" at Wilton and discover long-buried treasures! Join George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, and Patrick Henry and explore the meaning of "Liberty." Take a scavenger hunt in the oldest public graveyard in Richmond, make a colonial wig, and participate as one of the delegates to the Second Virginia Convention!
